S. SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING

Students are taught through this 30-minute assembly to be conscious of their surroundings. If they see someone getting bullied, they should say something to an adult.

M. MAKE NEW FRIENDS

Rascal will teach students how to make new friends. When they see someone that is new to the school, make friends with them...don't make fun of them for being "the new kid in school".

I. INCLUDE EVERYONE

Whether you are eating lunch in the cafeteria or playing outside during recess...if you see someone alone, invite them to play/eat with you. Just being included is a great feeling to have and can change someone's day.

L. LEADERSHIP

Be a leader. Don't make fun of someone or talk bad about them to make yourself "look cool". You are the example, so treat people how you would like to be treated.

E. EDUCATE

You have been given the tools to be successful in combatting bullying. Use those tools to go and educate others to be a buddy NOT a bully. Bullying is...NOT OK!
